## Down in the Jungle

Instrumentation:
SG/AG
SXIAX
BX/CBB (D, E, G, B)
Tubanos (2 Low)
Vibraslaps (2)

## Form: ABACABA

Intro: Improvise jungle sounds on instruments and with voices
A: Everyone softly speaks the poem twice. No accompaniment except for the special effect instruments.
B: Divide into four mallet groups: AX, SX, AG, SG. Play B 4X, adding a group each time. Accompaniment plays.
A: Same.
C: Mallet Safari. AX first time, SX second time. (or xylophones 1st time, glocks 2nd time)
A: Same.
B: Play B 4. Begin with all 4 mallet groups. One drops out each time through/ (SG, AG, SX, AX) Accompaniment plays.
A: Same
Coda: More jungle sound improvisations. Gradually fade out.

## FORM:

- Play the alto xylophone part once.
- Add the bass xylophone part and play once.
- Add the soprano xylophone part and play once.
- Add the contrabass xylophone part and the shakere and play once.
- Each part gets to play as a solo one time through with no repeat.
- Play once all together between soloists.
- After the contrabass xylophone solo, play the $B$ section.
- Play twice all together and show "HEY" on the last beat of the last measure.
- Possibly use shakere, maracas, or tambourine to keep steady pulse throughout.
